

## How to revise Spanish:

1. RAG rate the revision list opposite; red for areas of weakness, amber/yellow for areas you feel 'comfortable' in and green for areas you feel confident in.
2. Look, cover, write, check.
3. Revise language little and often and split up revision into small, manageable chunks.
4. Say it: say the words out loud in Spanish to help you remember them. Keep repeating.
5. Use your sentence builder to make flash cards. It may help to use different coloured pens when revising.
6. Use post it notes and stick the difficult words up at home where you can see them.
