Sensation & perception	➤ The difference between sensation and perception
Visual cues and constancies	➤ Monocular including height in the plane, occlusion, relative size, and linear perspective ➤ binocular depth cues including convergence and retinal disparity
Theories of Perception	➤ Gregory's Constructivist Theory of Perception ➤ Gibsons Direct Theory of Perception
Visual illusions	➤ Size constancy, misinterpreted depth cues to include; Muller Lyer illusion, Ponzo Illusion, Ambiguous images (Necker cube, Rubin's Vase) and fictions (Kanizsa triangle)
