A deeper study of fundamental mathematics using year 7 core Number and proportion knowledge to apply to the three other strands of mathematical content. Algebra, Geometry and Measure and Statistics and probability

Half Term	Curriculum Plan
1	Manipulating and simplifying expressions - starting to look at combining algebra with the number skills from year 7. Time, estimation and use of a calculator - starting to look at GCSE number knowledge of error intervals and truncation.
2	Drawing, measuring and constructing. An introduction to using mathematical equipment. Ruler, compass and protractor. Manipulating and simplifying expressions. An extension from half term 1 with a look at how we use algebra in contextual settings.
3	Linear equations - starting to look at solving equations and what they represent. Proportional reasoning. Applications of basic number skills into contextual situations such as best buys, scaling and financial maths.
4	Polygons and angles - expanding on the knowledge discovered in half term 2 to begin to solve geometrical problems. Discrete data – using the data handling cycle - collecting, representing and analysing data
5	Ratio. Using formulae with curriculum links to science, computing and elements of DT - possible extensions into compound measures.
6	Bivariate data and time series and scatter diagrams. The cartesian grid. Co-ordinates, graphs and equations.
