How to revise Spanish:

- 1. RAG rate the revision list opposite; red for areas of weakness, amber/yellow for areas you feel 'comfortable' in and green for areas you feel confident in.
- 2. Look, cover, write, check.
- 3. Revise language little and often and split up revision into small, manageable chunks.
- 4. Say it: say the words out loud in Spanish to help you remember them. Keep repeating.
- 5. Use your vocabulary lists to make flash cards. It may help to use different coloured pens when revising.
- 6. Use post it notes and stick the difficult words up at home where you can see them.
