GCSE RS Exam Skills (Quick Guide)

- Britain is **mainly Christian but diverse**
- Include **religious + non-religious views** (e.g. atheism, humanism)
- Use **teachings & sources of authority** (e.g. Bible)
- Explain **different arguments**:
 - Religious
 - Ethical (right/wrong)
 - Philosophical (ideas)
- In answers:
- ✓ Give **2 viewpoints**
- ✓ Use **religious evidence**
- ✓ Explain **why people disagree**

AO1 & AO2 (Quick Guide)

AO1 = Knowledge (Explain)

- Beliefs, practices & sources (e.g. Bible)
- Influence on people & society
- Similarities & differences between religions

AO2 = Evaluation (Discuss)

- Analyse & evaluate arguments
- Give different views
- Explain importance and impact

Key idea:

Always **support your answer with religion + explain clearly.**

Simple rule:

- **AO1 = what beliefs are**
- **AO2 = what you think about them (with reasons)**
